

Something is Wrong

Something is wrong with the general explanation of UFOs and the Alien phenomena. In some ways, looking at the phenomena can prompt one to ask, “What is wrong with this picture?” Alternatively, we can concern ourselves with why the things that happen are happening rather than just accepting the standard explanations at face value. For example, if you ask the average person with a little bit of knowledge of UFOs how they would summarize the subject it would probably go something like the following. UFO’s came on the scene in the mid 1940s and were first referred to as saucers in relationship to a sighting by Kenneth Arnold in 1947. Subsequently there was the crash of a saucer in Roswell, New Mexico, in 1947 where a craft and bodies were retrieved. Since then there have been widespread sightings everywhere around the world including over Washington, DC itself in 1952. The craft are generally disc shaped, rotate, and fly in a manner inconsistent with any normal aircraft.

This is all reasonably familiar, but the picture it paints is both incomplete and highly misleading. The things we refer to as Unidentified Flying Objects have been around since well before the mid 1940s. Almost a hundred years earlier strange flying craft were seen in the skies but even this is not the whole story. Literally hundreds and thousands of years earlier objects flying in the skies have been both seen and recorded. There are various paintings and drawings of such objects back to the beginning of man’s recorded history. Whatever UFOs are, they are not a new phenomena or recent occurrence. Also, they appear to have had the same kind of capability thousands of years ago as they do today, and that is one of the first things that should strike us as being odd.

In less than seventy years we progressed from the first fledgling aircraft to spacecraft reaching the Moon. We went from travelling a few tens of miles per hour, to thousands of miles per hour. Our technological progress has been astounding. Even in the computer era the capability of our technological creations in the last few years has been incredible. Yet over thousands of years there does not appear to be any significant advancement of alien technology in relationship to their flying craft. Additionally, if we believe what we read, the aliens who come here across tens or hundred of light years have a rather high rate of crashing their flying craft all around the world. It just seems that alien technology that is perhaps thousands of years more advanced than we are should have a lot better flight record than we do with our commercial airliners which by all accounts are quite primitive by comparison.

This should cause us to wonder, just how advanced are these aliens anyway?

Again, if we believe what we read, the aliens come from the Pleiades, Tau Ceti, Zeta Reticulli, or any of a number of other star systems. However, the ages of the stars in these regions in relation to Sol (our star) points out an interesting situation. If a sentient race evolves or evolved in any of those regions they are more likely to be hundreds of millions of years ahead of us or else not even able to get off their own planet than being of just the right age to have mastered supra-light

space travel and be interested in visiting us. To put this in perspective, how interested in us would a human 100 million years from now be? Well, we are interested in dinosaurs, from an archeological and paleontological perspective, so there is that. So a highly advanced alien race might find us to be interesting curiosities, but interesting enough to study us in detail for thousands of years? Picture us spending a couple of thousand years studying gorillas in comparison.

Of course there is alternatively the suggestion that aliens are here to acquire some mineral that is in short supply elsewhere. That sounds good except for the fact that we really don't have a corner on the market of elements. Everything that is here was created "out there" in stars that expired long ago. Gold, silver, iron and lead among everything else has been forged in the heart of stars and blown all over creation. There is literally nothing on Earth that couldn't be found much closer to home for beings of any star system.

There is also the speculation that aliens are here to get something from our DNA or to manipulate our DNA or create some kind of hybrids between us and them. Of course this brings us to the whole issue of UFOs being observed for thousands of years. It would seem that anything that they want from our DNA would have been obtained a long time ago if it was of any value to them. Likewise if they were going to manipulate our DNA or create some kind of hybrid race it would have been a completed project a long time ago and there would be no further need to keep abducting people, performing operations on them, taking things out or putting things in.

This brings us to the implants. These are the small objects that people who have been abducted have reported being in their bodies. The Earth has been around a very long time, and we as a race of people have been around a very short time. Quite literally, it would be easy for over a hundred technologically advanced races to have risen to preeminence on the Earth prior to our arrival. Such races would, by definition, be

tens to hundred of thousands of years ahead of us. They could look similar to us with some significant differences. Their basic DNA would be much the same, but they could be reptilian, saurian, avian, amphibian or something else that would still be highly recognizable to us. Also, if they actually live here, they would be absolutely interested in what we are up to especially in regard to anything that might render the planet uninhabitable not just for us but for them also.

One would also note that such a race must have slipped from preeminence for some pretty good reason. This might be a genetic flaw, a war that devastated them, or climate changes that rendered the earth much less hospitable to them. Still, with technology, a remnant could survive and keep tabs on the situation looking for the opportunity to return to what they might believe is their rightful place in the grand scheme of things. In the meantime they wouldn't want people poking around their "home turf" so if anyone asked they would point them at the unreachable stars as their home.
